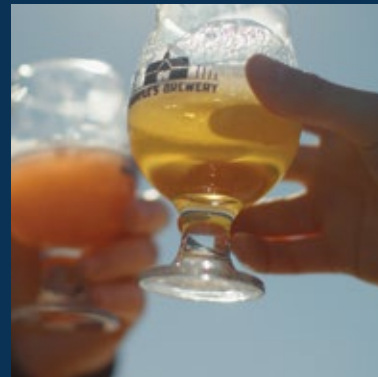
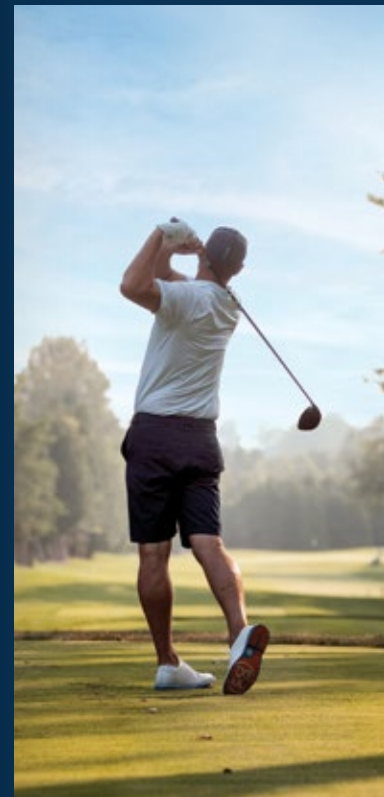
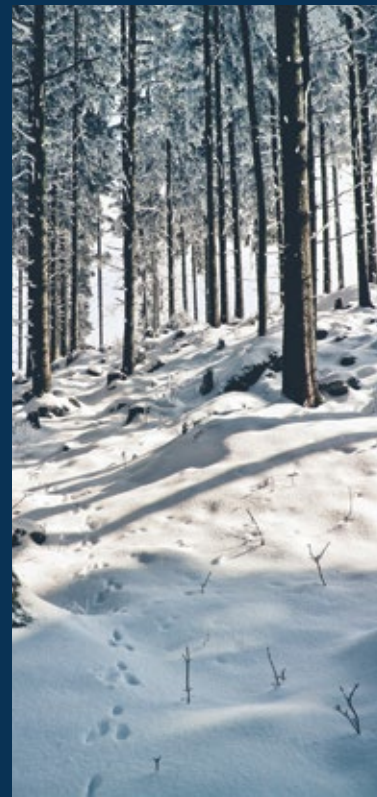
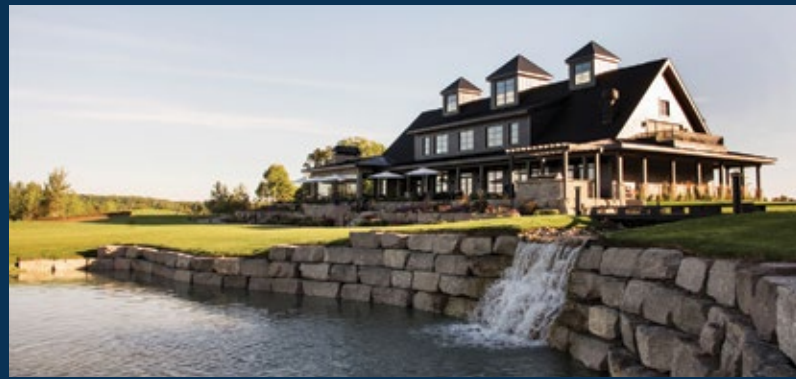
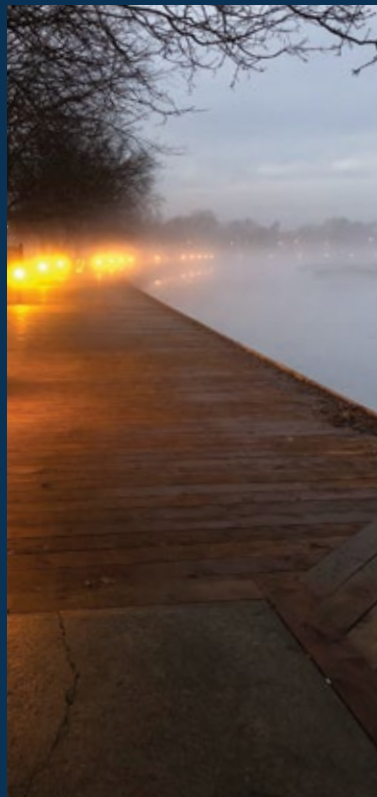
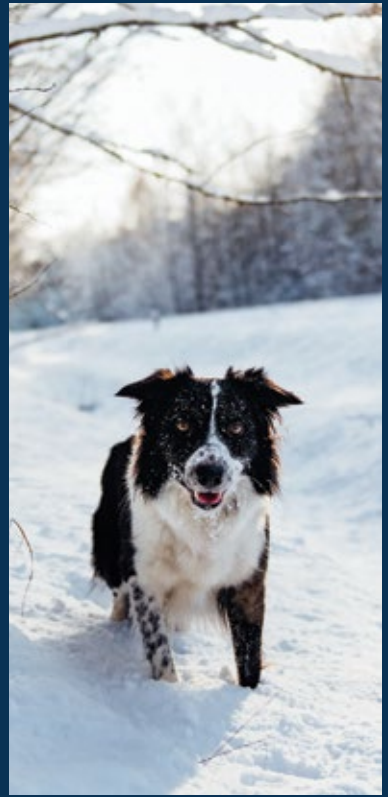
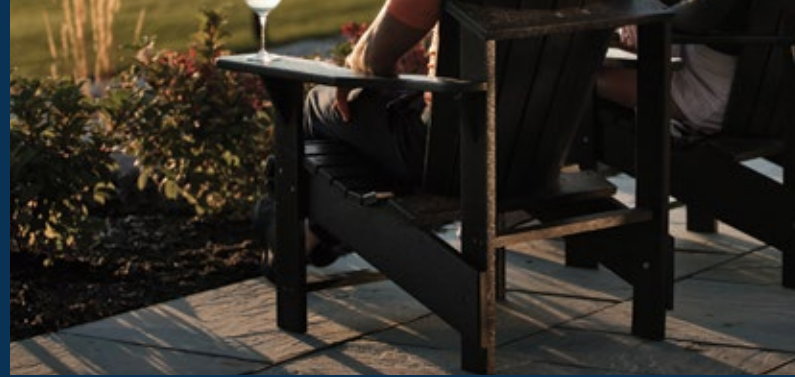
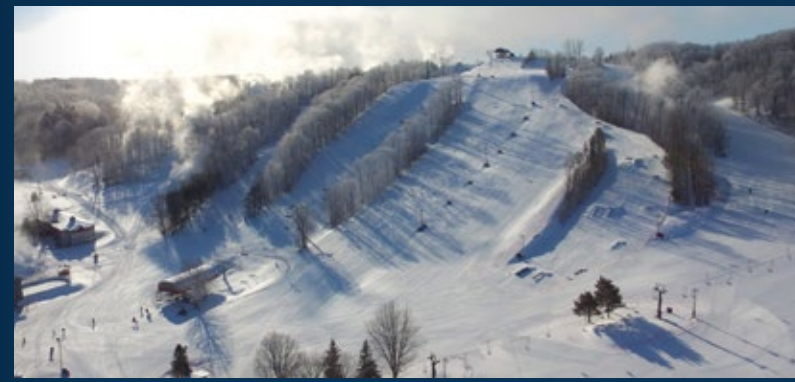
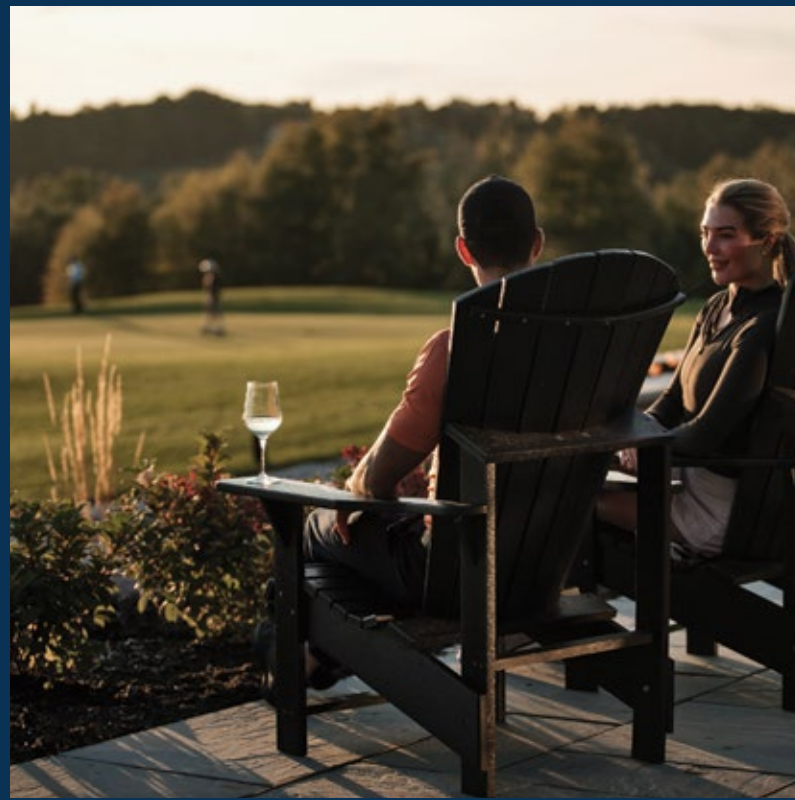


EVERY MOMENT COUNTS.

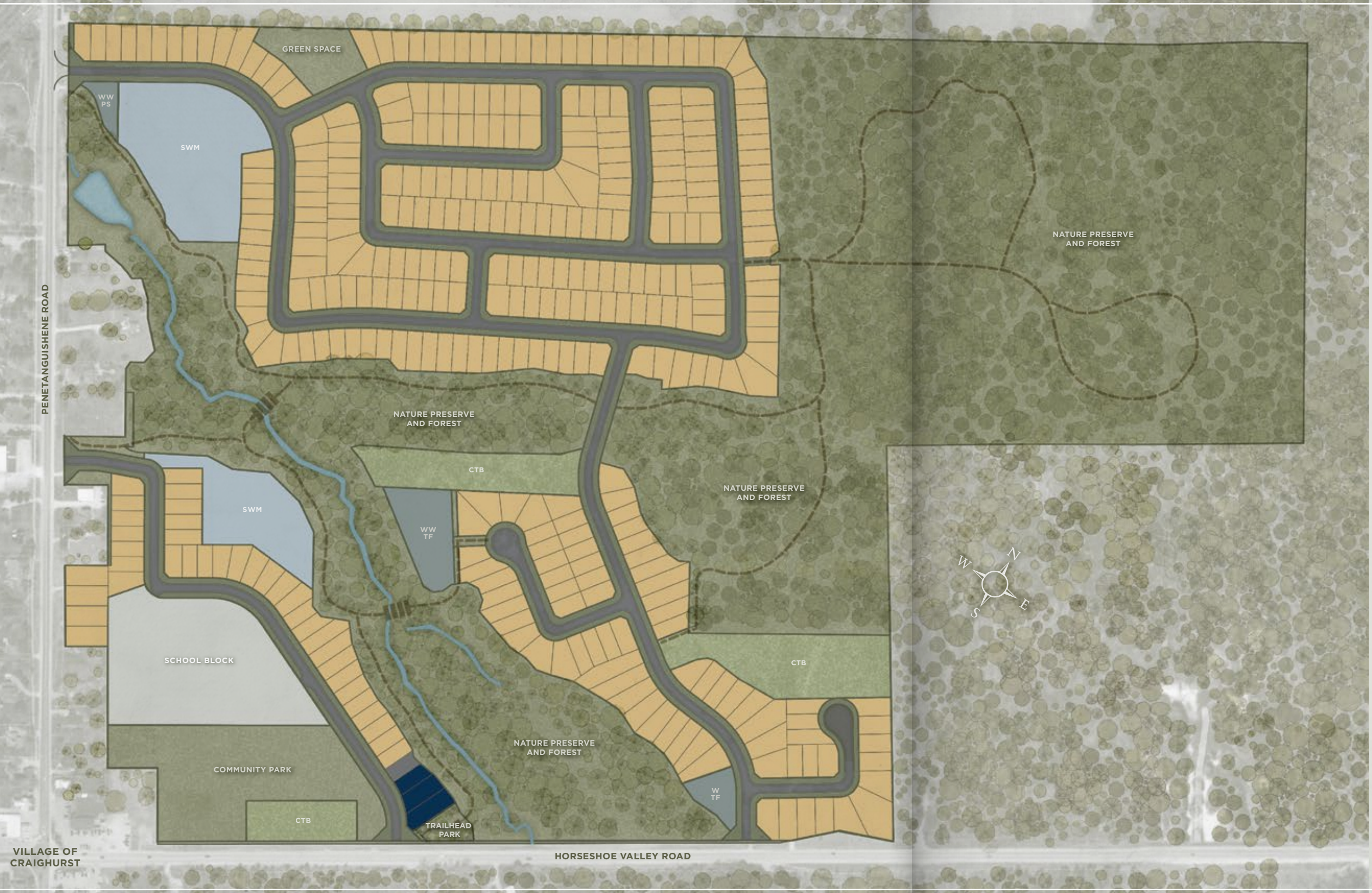

We are committed to crafting a future for Craighurst that honours its past and welcomes new possibilities for responsible growth.

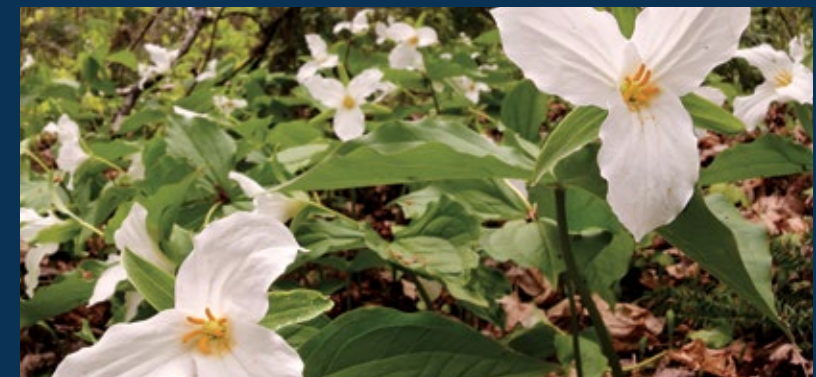
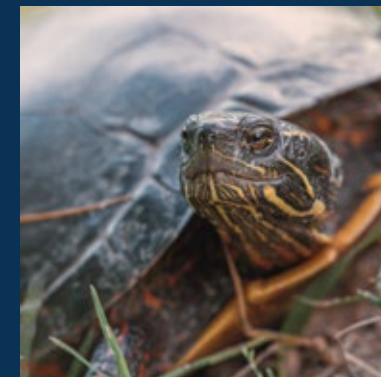
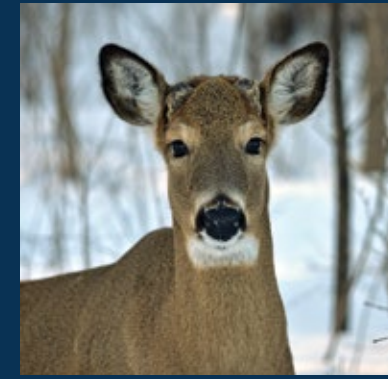


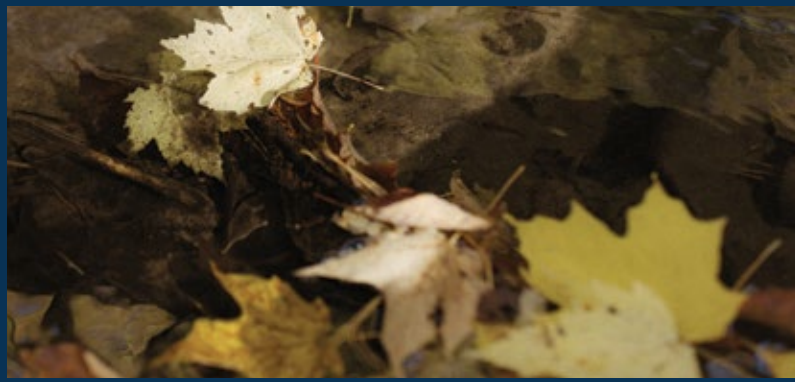


INTO THE FOREST.

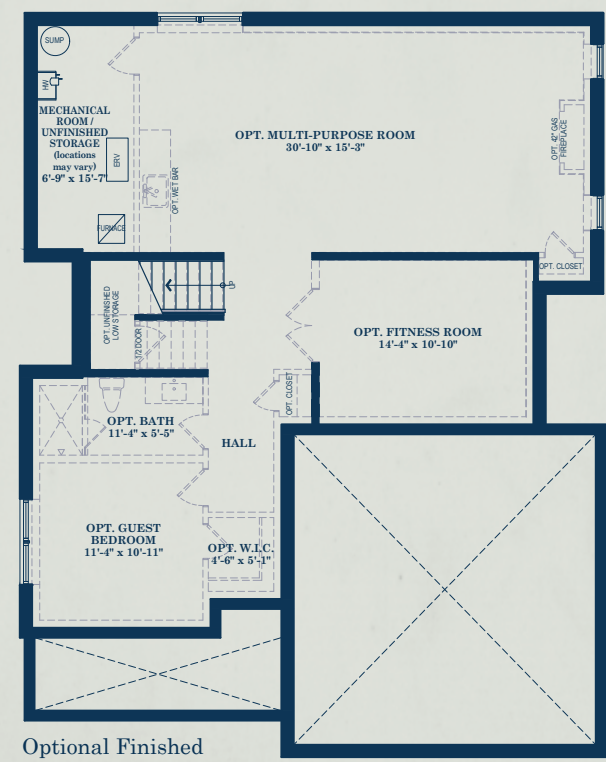
